What is Surrey Stars?

Surrey Stars is a strategic sustained attainment raising programme, developed collaboratively with partner schools, to provide a progressive programme of inschool and on-campus experiences for learners in Years 7 to 11.

The programme features targeted on-campus activity and embedded enrichment alongside our Aspirations Curriculum for the whole school. Through the activity provided, learners will receive the knowledge, understanding and agency to make confident, informed decisions about their future pathway.

Who are Surrey Stars?

Our activity is targeted for:

- · Students who are eligible for free school meals
- · Students who are care experienced
- Students from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community
- Students with a special educational need or disability

Programme Overview

Our 4 part programme is delivered by our team of Widening Participation & Outreach Officers and Student Ambassadors. All WPO Staff members have an enhanced DBS and regular safeguarding training. All Student Ambassadors receive safeguarding training and those involved in regular school activity are DBS checked. School staff should be present for all booked activity and are responsible for behaviour management. All of our events and workshops are completely free of charge.

Aspirations Curriculum

Our Aspirations Curriculum takes place in school and is available for the whole year group, designed to meet Gatsby Benchmarks. We offer two workshops per year group that are 60 minutes and can be adapted or doubled up to fill 100-120 minute lessons. **Perfect for drop down or off timetable days.**

Embedded Enrichment

We deliver interactive STEM themed workshops in school for the whole year group based on university research and courses. We offer two workshops per year group that are 60 minutes and can be adapted or doubled up to fill 100-120 minute lessons. **Perfect for drop down or off timetable days.**

Campus Visits

Campus visits are scheduled on specific dates for a capacity of 35 Surrey Stars eligible learners. These are full day, multi school events (10:00 -14:30) and include campus tour and lunch for all. Transport is provided to and from the University of Surrey. School uniform must be worn by all learners.

Attainment Raising Activity

We are offering a programme of sustained activity for Surrey Stars learners to support towards raising attainment levels. Each provision takes place in school to complement teaching timetables across a half term or full term dependent on frequency of sessions.



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Our offer for Y7 learners:

Aspirations Curriculum

Workshop: Enterprise Overview: Learners make group decisions to solve a real-world issue. Gatsby Benchmarks: 4, 7

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Workshop: Introduction to University Overview: Learners discover the similarities/differences between school and university.

Gatsby Benchmarks: 7, 8

Embedded Enrichment

Workshop: Virtually Vets Overview: An introduction to the world of veterinary medicine through practical exercises and insights from our veterinary students.

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Workshop: How to win at Rock, Paper, Scissors Overview: An introduction to probability and game theory and how both mathematical concepts are applied within a game of Rock, Paper, Scissors.

Campus Visit

Workshop: University Start

Overview: Learners visit the University of Surrey as an introduction to higher education. The visit will involve an interactive campus tour along with subject taster workshops.

Programme: Rapid Group Reading

Our group reading programme can be embedded as part of the timetable once a week for a half term or once a fortnight across a whole term. Reading books are provided to all participants who participate in groups of 6.

Workshop: Choosing Options Overview: Learners are introduced to different decision making methods to inform their GCSE choices. Gatsby Benchmarks: 3, 4, 7, 8

Workshop: Student Life Overview: Learners receive an insight into a student's university experience.

Embedded Enrichment

Workshop: Psychology of the Senses

Overview: Learners complete a carousel of different sensory experiments, covering sight, sound, hearing and smell, and testing the interaction between two or more different senses (e.g. how hearing can affect the way we see things).

Workshop: Design, Build, Reuse Overview: Combining engineering skills with business acumen, learners compete to success construct 3 structures with minimal resources whilst recording the most profit.

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Campus Visit

Workshop: Exploring Higher Education

Overview: Learners design their own university through a series of subject workshops and pathway mapping, across our mulit day event concluding with an in school Graduation.

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Attainment Raising Activity

Programme: Creativity Unbound

Our creative writing programme can be embedded as part of the timetable once a week for a half term or once a fortnight across a whole term. Participants tap into their creativity through a shared theme with the option to perform/record their piece writing at the end of the programme.

Workshop: Goal Mapping Overview: Learners reflect on and consider their learning interests and study/career goals. Gatsby Benchmarks: 3, 4, 7, 8

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Workshop: Student Living Overview: Learners are provided an overview of student finances, including loans, bursaries and scholarships. Gatsby Benchmarks: 7, 8

Embedded Enrichment Workshop: Ready, Steady, Pitch

Overview: An interactive workshop encouraging students to conceptualise a product or service before presenting their business idea to the panel.

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Workshop: No Crane, No Gain Overview: A construction challenge using Mechano, learners are tasked with building and testing their designs to see who can successfully build the highest/strongest crane using engineering principles and problem solving.

Campus Visit

Workshop: School, Skills & Beyond

Overview: This visit makes connections between study options/choices and their attributed career pathways. Hear from our current students about their education experience and career aspirations.
